

## COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made in (City) \_\_\_\_\_,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the execution of this Agreement, and the  
undertakings of the parties as hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

1. The parties shall collaborate in the writing of the Work and upon completion  
thereof all writers will receive writing credit in all movie posters and publicity ma-  
terials. (You can add this line if you have already decided whose name comes

2. It is understood and agreed that both Writers will be compensated as follow:  
Writer 1 will receive **(what percentages do you agree on) 50%** of profits and  
Writer 2 will receive **50%** of profits from all payments, options, purchases and  
royalties of the Work as well as any other money coming from the work becoming  
a play or a book or other exploitations of the work in other mediums.

3. It is understood and agreed that Writer 1 and Writer 2 both have equal au-  
thority to control and exploit the rights to the Work and through licensing the  
world for adaptations into a play and any other artistic/entertainment platform and  
medium.

4. Both Writers agree to respect these terms and if there are any other rights  
not covered in this agreement both writers agree to sign another Collaboration  
Agreement to include those rights and negotiate in good faith.
